Exercise books, IT subscriptions and textbooks will be provided at school and charged to students' accounts.

Year 5 and 6 students require a personal laptop and headphones. We recommend that it is covered with a protective case as they are carried around the school grounds. Please contact our IT department if you need further detail about the technology requirements.

Excursions and additional activities will be charged to accounts to recover costs from parents in a process called Pupil Recovery. This will include excursions, performances, camps, competitions, swimming programs, sports registrations, co-curricular activities and classroom materials that are required throughout the year. School food is not included in the tuition fees and will be billed to parents each term. Opting out of school food will be available prior to the term commencing and will not be adjusted within the school term. Families opting out must notify the school prior to the term commencement. The school bus levy covers transport to and from local events and is a set cost of \$30 per year. The Student Activity Fee is included in the tuition fees for K - 6 and includes - student insurance, IPSHA/PSSA fees, portfolios, school diaries, classroom supplies and NAPLAN costs. I hope the 2017 fee restructure will create a more transparent process for parents.

Students require stationary throughout the year and therefore, HB pencils, exercise books, scrap books and replacement materials may be charged to student's accounts each term to ensure all children have the correct supplies.

Please label all equipment with your child's name to ensure their equipment is returned to them when misplaced.
